"So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also out to wash one another's feet." (John 13:14)

Today is Maundy Thursday – the day before Jesus' death.

The word 'Maundy' comes from the Latin *mandatum*, which literally means "mandate" or "commandment." In some churches, often in other traditions, Maundy Thursday is marked by a service that includes the ancient ritual of foot washing. It is a reminder of the story of Jesus' foot washing found in the Gospel of John. In the act of washing another's feet – the commandment of loving one another is physically symbolized. It is a gesture of loving servanthood and a hallmark of discipleship.

A couple of years ago, when my son was the music director at St Paul's Anglican, I participated in their Maundy Thursday service that included foot washing. The Minister humbly knelt at the front with a basin of water, a jug, and a collection of towels. As I awkwardly removed my socks and shoes and came forward, there was a deep sense of intimacy to allow this man to silently wash my feet. It was a humbling experience, full of vulnerability, liberation, and love.

I am aware that literally exposing one's feet to be washed is not an easy practice for many Canadians. In the United Church, taking socks and shoes off during worship is uncommon. But since we are not gathered in the sanctuary, and we are in the safety of our own homes — why not try it? If you are able, I invite you to gather a bowl, a jug, and towel, and take turns with a partner or a friend (in the same bubble of course) in kneeling to wash each other's feet. Like me, you may find this to be a truly transforming experience.


Prayer: We are humbled by Jesus' intimate act of love.

Easter Resurrection Rolls

Ingredients

- 1 can Pillsbury Crescent Dough
- 8 large marshmallows
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- 1 Tbsp cinnamon & ¼ cup brown sugar mixed together in a bowl

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F. Spray a cookie sheet with cooking spray or line with parchment paper.
- 2. Unroll crescent dough and separate each triangle. [This is like the cloth they wrapped Jesus in.]
- 3. Brush each triangle with melted butter. [This symbolizes the embalming oils.]
- 4. Sprinkle each triangle then with the cinnamon/brown sugar mixture. [This is like the spices used to prepare his body for burial.]
- 5. Place marshmallow [representing Jesus] in the top of the crescent roll and roll into a crescent roll shape, then secure the sides by tucking them under and pinching them closed. (Don't worry about how they look! They will be yummy!) [This represents how they wrapped Jesus' body.]





- 6. Place on prepared cookie sheet and repeat with remaining 7 rolls.
 - 7. Bake in preheated oven [symbolizing the tomb] for 8-10 minutes or until golden brown on the outside.
 - 8. Let cool for a few minutes and cut open. The marshmallow has disappeared! [This signifies how Jesus has been resurrected.]
 - 9. Enjoy! (we can enjoy them together during our coffee time Zoom on Sunday)


