IN-PERSON WORSHIP NEXT SUNDAY!

Next Sunday – June 27th, we will be having a LIVE outdoor worship behind the church, beside the parking lot. It is exciting to be able to gather, but we must follow the restrictions to stay safe:

- Please bring your own chair and place it by the flags as indicated by the ushers.

If you are feeling pain or distress because of your residential school experiences, please call the free 24-hour crisis line: 1-866-925-4419. You can also call the First Nations and Inuit Hope for Wellness Help Line at 1-855-242-3310. It's toll-free and open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Earlier this month, the undocumented and unmarked graves of 215 children were discovered on the site of Kamloops Residential School. Like you, this news has filled us with feelings of sorrow, concern, and outrage.

Our connection to the United Church of Canada – which operated 15 Residential Schools – gives us the responsibility to move towards Truth and Reconciliation with our First Nations neighbours.

We ask that you take the time to read a message from The Rt. Rev. Dr. Richard Bott, Moderator and The Rev. Murray Pruden, Executive Minister of Indigenous Ministries and Justice at The United Church of Canada by clicking the link below.
