A United Church Response to the Housing Crisis

In the last few months we have become painfully aware that there is a housing crisis in most of Canada. And it's not just affecting the poor. Even middle class young people struggle to find an affordable place to live. This concern has prompted many United Churches to re-imagine what they can do with their own property.

Churches have always been used as gathering spaces for enrichment, community and transformation. Now some are looking at using their property for housing as well.

Two years ago, the United Church formed the United Property Resource Corporation (UPRC) to help ensure

that its church properties are able to continue to serve the common good. This year the UPRC joined with architects, community leaders, culture visionaries and investors to form Kindred Works which will help individual churches in their desire to reduce the housing crisis in their local community. Currently, Kindred Works has eight projects in active pre-development to build 600 homes and will expand to 1,500 homes by the end of year.

The overall goal of Kindred Works is to build housing for 34000 people on church properties over the next 15 years. All of the units will be rental which thus provides a source of income for the involved church. One third of these housing units will be



available at below market prices. The units are designed to produce 80% less carbon and use 65% less energy than today's industry standards and will be built by local labour and businesses. One third of the units will be universally accessible.

The General Secretary of the United Church Michael Blair reminds us that, in our New Creed, we are invited to continually rearticulate our faith with new words and new concepts. Kindred Work is the United Church's re-articulation of its faith with regards to property. A church could be used not only as a gathering space but also as a place for low-cost housing.
