POLICY: BAPTISM POLICY

Preamble

In baptism, children, youth, adults become members of Grace church and its faith community.

The community of faith makes a commitment to support and nurture them in their faith development.

Approval

Requests for baptism will be received through the minister.

All requests will be received and considered on an individual basis by Session, and must be approved by Session.

To help the community of faith fulfill its vow, Grace United Church requires:

1. Parents to be connected to "The Church" through participation in the life and mission of Grace United Church. Families are expected to be regularly attending worship at Grace to fulfill their baptismal vow to share with their child the Christian life, and grow in faith together. At least one parent must be a member of Grace United Church.
2. This sacrament will be celebrated within the church family in the context of Sunday morning worship.
3. Families will participate in baptismal preparation. The minister will meet with the parents to discuss the ceremony, the promises and responsibilities involved, and to share resources.
4. The sacrament of baptism may be celebrated with a teenager or adult after they have participated in membership preparation classes or an equivalent.
